Greater Kingston Curling Policies for Financial Support of Junior Curling

From Our Mission and Objectives:

Junior Curling

- Provide financial funding for the clubs to improve and promote their junior curling programs.
- Manage and maintain the GKC Junior Curling Intermural League for the 4 clubs to participate in a fun recreational curling league.
- Assist through funding and support the objective to keep junior curling programs, leagues and memberships affordable for easy participation.
- Host junior clinics bringing in expert coaches, professional role model curlers and educators to inspire and teach our youth.
- Facilitate a "competitive" stream to offer our aspiring Greater Kingston Curling member club competitive junior curlers with competitive opportunities for games, learning and peak performance.

Funding Source for Junior Curling

- Funds to support Junior Curling in the Greater Kingston Area have been raised through lotteries licensed by the Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO)
- Junior Curling Coordinators from the four member Clubs of GKC need to familiarize themselves with the spending eligibility guidelines as outlined by the AGCO. Details can be found in the Lottery Licencing Policy Manual 4360E (2020/10), pages 59 to 65, sections 2.7.4 (C)(i) to 2.7.4(C)(x). https://www.agco.ca/lottery-and-gaming/lottery-licensing-policy-manual-llpm
- The number of granted requests for funding will be subject to available funds in any given curling season.

Financial funding for 4 member clubs

- Provide up to \$1000 in annual funding for junior curling program for each club (assuming the member club is open and has an active junior program).
- GKC member clubs can submit additional funding requests for extraordinary expenses in support junior curling beyond the \$1000
- Again, spending requests need to satisfy the eligibility guidelines as outlined by the AGCO.
- Funding requests must be submitted with the attached Junior Curling Funding Request Form and corresponding receipts must be submitted once funding requests have been granted (to satisfy the audit requirements of the AGCO).

GKC Junior Curling Intermural League

• The eligible expenses (according to AGCO guidelines) associated with the GKC Junior Curling Intermural league will continue to be supported annually.

Support for Competitive Curlers

- The number of granted requests for funding will be subject to available funds in any given curling season.
- Assuming funds are available, GKC will pay the initial entry fees for Curl ON and Ontario
 Curling Council (e.g. Ontario Winter Games) competitions for teams that actively curl at
 and compete out of a GKC member club. <u>Teams need to submit their request for entry
 fees subsidy by November 1st of the current curling season.* Decisions about funding
 will be communicated to individuals/teams by November 30th.
 </u>
- In addition, GKC member club teams who reach the level of a provincial competition will be given \$600/team to help cover expenses associated with participating in that provincial competition. If GKC junior club members curl with a non GKC team, they will be eligible for \$150/curler. Receipts for expenses must be submitted for reimbursement.
- If a GKC member club teams reaches a national competition they will be given \$800/team or \$200/GKC curler. Again, receipts for expenses must be submitted for reimbursement.
- Scholarship Program curlers can apply for \$350/individual curler to cover expenses associated with their season plan for development as a curler (document attached). Applications must be received by November 1st of the current curling season.*
 *if funds are still available, applications submitted after the November 1st deadline may be entertained at the discretion of the GKC Board.

Junior Clinics

- GKC will arrange an annual clinic for GKC junior curlers to help in skills development.
- In order to support high performance adult teams in our area, priority will be given to contract these adult teams to deliver the skills development clinics.

Coach Development

 GKC will continue to support and subsidize GKC members to do coach training in order to maintain a pool of certified coaches to assist with Junior Programs and coach competitive teams.

Other funding requests that will be considered based on funds available

- Subsidize Rocks and Rings school programs (<u>www.rocksandrings.com</u>) and link it to a visit to one of the 5 GKC clubs.
- Support costs incurred by member clubs for hosting junior Curl ON competitions

Curlers must be 21 years old or younger as of June 30th in the current curling season.

Successful applicants will be reimbursed for expenses up to \$350 per curler upon presentation of receipts (dependent on funds available in the current curling season)

Handwritten or incomplete applications will not be reviewed. YOUR RESPONSES MUST BE TYPED. Type answers in the Word document, save with your name as the title.

POINT FORM IS ACCEPTABLE FOR SECTIONS EXCEPT THE PERSONAL ESSAY.

Please indicate what level of curler you are. Are you competing on the Ontario Junior Curling Tour, in CurlON competitions, or in the Junior Slam Series? If so, you are competitive. If you are still working on your skills, participating in U15 Slam Series Development, CurlON Skills Camps or are working on your skills and want to start participating in a bonspiel, you are probably Developmental.
